## **Split Ring Flower with Joined Hanging Cluny Leaves**

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This pretty little flower is perfect for a bookmark giveaway or to tuck into a get well card. Tatted flowers don't make anyone sneeze and they never wilt.

Begin with a yard or two of a variegated flower color thread on a shuttle and a long thread end about 24"

Center:

Ring A (2-2-2-2-2-2) Leave a thread space about the size of a picot *MOCK PICOT*.

Flower Petal Rings:


Split Ring B ( 2 - 3 - 3 / 2 ) Split Rings CDEFG ( 2 + 2 / 3 - 3 ) Split Ring H ( 2 + 2 + 3 / 3 )

Wind about 1.5 yards of green thread on a shuttle and leave a tail about a yard long.

Make a hanging cluny leaf leaving about 18" tail. Wrap the threads as usual, but when you get to the end make one more wrap. Go over the thread, under the floss threader, then do a down join to the picot of Split Ring G. Continue around the far thread, over the floss threader, and then back under the near thread.

Put the end through the eye of the floss threader and pull it down through the cluny. Pull the loom thread down through the cluny as you normally would and then tighten up the threads.

Tat a lock stitch ( second half not flipped, then second half DS flipped ). This knot will not slip.



To finish, turn the piece over and repeat the cluny, joining to Split Ring B. Use the ends from the flower and leaves to make twisted cord and a tassel. No ends to hide!!! Enjoy
