
TATTING AND TENERIFE

ABBREVIATION TATTING

Ch = chain

SCH = split chain

Clr = close ring

R = ring

- = picot

MP = mock picot

SR = split ring

RW = reverse work

CTM = continuous thread method

1ª ROUND

CTM

R = 11 picot Clr. 1 MP.

2º ROUND

SR = 3DS - 3DS / 3DS - 3DS. Clr.

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Ch = 4DS - 4DS
R 1 = 3DS + (SR) 3DS + (-R) 3DS - 3DS. Clr. 11x
Ch = 4DS - SCH 4DS. MP. RW
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3º ROUND

SR = 6DS - 4DS - 1DS - 1DS - 1DS - 4DS. Clr.

Ch = 4DS - 1DS - 1DS - 1DS - 1DS - 1DS - 1DS - 4DS + (-SR). R = 6DS + (-Ch) 6DS - 4DS - 1DS - 1DS - 1DS - 4DS. Clr. 12x. Cut and Tie.

TENERIFE

Round loom with 7cm (2,7559) in diameter, with 36 nails

Thread in straw and green.

With the line in straw color, go around the first nail and a knot about 1 cm beyond the middle of the loom, leaving an edge of about 10 centimeters.

Take the line to the first nail on the opposite side of the loom, pass around the same side and back, passing through the initial second nail ... and so on ... until it fills the entire loom.

Cut the thread, leaving a piece of about 15 cm. Tie a knot in the end that was the beginning and go through above and below by 6x

With the straw thread stuck in the first pair of threads, run the needle under it, and over the next, under the third pair, and so up to the end of the wires marked in the picture where we divide the sides of the loom. This will make a frame loom.

At the end of the marked pairs again with the needle, passing now reversed, is where passed over, go under, and vice- versa. Pull the thread and align it with the first. When you reach the end of their row, go back doing the same procedure to complete 4 rounds.

Start separating the leaves 6 wires and working 10 rows, one above another wire underneath (roundtrip), 6 rows with 4 wires and 6 rows with 2 strands. Repeat this process for 6 sheets.

finish

Take a pair of thread each nail and tie a knot. Tie knots all around.

Repeat the process by making a knot in the line between the threads of each nail and a knot in the cord itself, forming an inverted V.

Make a knot between the two thread of each nail leaving a gap in the thread not to pucker the job. Do all around.

Cut the wire and pass to glue cloth, for not untie.
