SCMR = Self closing mock ring

Elements – Clover, Rings, Chains, Onion Rings

Techniques must be – Blipless Join and 1 Split Ring in each quadrant.

Joins – swirl, alligator, up, down, Catherine wheel, Blipless (must be included), Larks head join.

Picots – twisted, dot, double and triple picots, these can be counted as individual picots, inverted picots, daisy picot, block tatting can be used for picots as well as they have a tiny picot on each row, woven picots, inward facing picots.

Chains can be – Josephine or spiral, Victorian sets = node sets and zig zag, folded, inverted picots, lock, rick rack, padded, dead, split, pearl tatting, block tatting (series of chains), split, roll tatting, mignonette.

RINGS can be – half closed rings, Single Shuttle Split Rings, Square Rings, Interlocking Rings, Stacked Rings, Ring on Ring, curled ring, Inward Facing Rings, Split Ring, Self-Closing Mock Ring or SCMR, regular tatted ring, Josephine Rings, thrown rings, dimpled rings.

Cards that were picked

Chain Cards

7 picots separated by 5 double stitches SCMR.

1 picot separated by 5 double stitches = 5ds picot 5ds = 5-5

5 picots separated by 1 double stitch.

3 picots separated by 5 double stitches.

5 picots separated by 2 double stitches this one she said 2-2-2-2-2 should be an onion ring outer edge.

7 picots separated by 3 double stitches – SCMR should be center of a clover.

3 picots separated by 6 double stitches.

3 picots separated by 2 double stitches.

1 picot separated by 3 double stitches – node stitch chain.

5 picots separated by 3 double stitches.

7 picots separated by 3 double stitches – lock chain

5 picots separated by 7 double stitches - staggered heights picots 7-1-1-1-7

3 picots separated by 11 double stitches.

1 picot separated by 11 double stitches.

5 picots separated by 11 double stitches.

7 picots separated by 11 double stitches.

1 picot separated by 13 double stitches.

7 picots separated by 13 double stitches.

3 picots separated by 13 double stitches

3 picots separated by 15 double stitches 5-5-5

3 picots separated by 1 double stitch / can use any stitch count.

Ring Cards

3 picots separated by 15 double stitches.

7 picots separated by 15 double stitches.

5 picots separated by 11 double stitches.

5 picots separated by 9 double stitches.

3 picots separated by 6 double stitches.

1 picot separated by 7 double stitches.

3 picots separated by 3 double stitches.

1 picot separated by 3 double stitches.
