

## Supply list for The flower brooch project turned into a nice hair band for both ladies and children.

### Scunci No-Slip Grip Flexible Headbands



### Cousin DIY Metal Alligator Barrette



### Eclectic E6000 Industrial Adhesive, Clear



Perle Cotton size 8 or any soft textured thread you have on hand. You will need green for the leaves and any color for the flower you choose. DMC Cebelia would be a good second choice in size 20. Aunt Lydia's crochet cotton would also work. You do not want a stiff thread for this project.

Size 3mm seed beads 7 beads only

1 hair clip as shown above

1 head band as shown above.

Any glue that will hold metal to plastic. E-6000 is my choice of glue for this project they also make a jeweler's glue that works really well.

A small piece of sandpaper to scuff the metal and plastic so they both have some bite to them.

Make sure to load 1 shuttle CTM Continuous thread method with the choice of flower color and 6 of the 7 beads loaded between the shuttle and ball thread. Have a second shuttle loaded continuous thread method with the same flower color.

Fill one more shuttle CTM with the green leaf color you choose. This will save time in class. Most of the supplies can be found at Walmart with a very reasonable price.
