
A note from the designer

On round 4 after the chains, I will make the join and then add a un flipped 1/2 stitch. I use the 2nd half, as added insurance to make sure my placement of that chain does not move. You will not see that added stitch in your work nor will it change the counts. This little tip I use in all my tatting. If I see a purpose or the need to do so.

Abbreviations

R=Ring RW= Reverse Work DNR=Do not reverse CI - close - = picot (vs s m L)

Ch=chain L J= Lock Join Up join chain shaping TOR = Thrown off ring

Note: pattern written by a right-handed tatter Two shuttle CTM

Round 1

Split ring 8/-vs 8 cl DNR

Split ring *8/8 cl DNR

Repeat from * until total of 6 rings and IJ last ring to first ring at picot DNR, Do not cut.

Round 2

Ch *6, TOR 6 cl ½ stitch (2nd half), Ch 6 LJ to junction between the next split ring

Repeat from * to complete round DNR Do not cut

Round 3

Ch *12 –(vs) 12 LJ to junction of next chains

Repeat from * around to complete round Do not cut RW

Round 4 the POINT

Ch 11 L J to next picot RW

1st center ring

*R 16 -16 CI RW this ring I tatted in RODS

First Left side chain

CH 4 TOR 6 CL 1/2ST 3 TOR 6 ---- 6DS CL 1/2ST 3 TOR 6 CL 1/2ST 4 L J TO NEXT PICOT RW

2nd center ring

R 16-16 CI RW this ring I tatted in RODS

Second Left side chain

CH 4 TOR 6 CL 1/2ST 3 TOR 6 --- 6 CL 1/2ST 3 TOR 6 CL 1/2ST 4 L J TO NEXT PICOT DNR

TOP TOR R 6 ---- 6 CL JOIN TO THE SAME PICOT OF THE PREV CENTER RING DNR

Right side for second ring

Ch TOR 6 CL 1/2ST 3 TOR 6--- 6 CL 1/2ST 3 TOR 6 CL 1/2ST 4 LJ to same picot from previous ring DNR

Right side for first ring

CH 5 TOR 6 CL 1/2ST 3 TOR 6 ---- 6 CL 1/2ST TOR 6 CL 1/2ST 4 LJ TO SAME PICOT OF ROUND 3

CH 11 LJ to junction between chains of round 3 DNR

CH 11 LJ to next picot

Repeat from * until you have made 6 points. Cut and hide ends
