## Earrings '2015-V' © 2015 by Nina Libin

For a pair of earrings you will need: about 4 yards of 3-ply metallic embroidery thread and 288 (290) seed beads size 11, one shuttle and ball. (cotton thread size 20 or even 10 with size 10 beads will look good too),



Load 1½ yard of thread with **112 beads** on the shuttle and leave ½ yard of thread with **32 beads** on as a ball.

## Pattern for ONE Earring:

1) R: 2 ···· 2-2 ··· 2.RW 8/8

2) CH: 1 ••• 2 •• 1. LJ to R1; RW 7/8

3) R: 2 • • • • 2-2 • • • 2.RW 8/8

4) CH: 1 ••• 2 •• 2 ••• 1.LJ to R3 7/8

5) R: 2 • • • • 2-2 • • • • 2.RW 8/8

6) CH: 1 ••• 2 •• 1.LJ to R6; RW 7/8

7) R: 2 • • • • 2-2 • • • • 2.RW 8/8

8) CH:  $1 \stackrel{\text{\tiny $\circ\circ$}}{\circ} 2 \stackrel{\text{\tiny $\circ\circ$}}{\circ} 2 \stackrel{\text{\tiny $\circ\circ$}}{\circ} 1$ .LJ to the base of R1, SLT

9) R: 1 • 1 • 1 • 2 • 2 • 1 • 1 • 1 . 14/6

Tie the tails and hide them inside 'blocks' of beads.

Symbols used through the pattern:

1, 2, 3 number of double stitches

R ring

CH chain

shape a chain, or close a ring

LJ lock join

1 seed bead 'up' & 1 'down'

• 2 seed beads 'up' & 1 'down'

**6** seed beads 'up' (beaded picot for ear wire)

'block' of 3 'up' & 3 'down' beads

'block' of 4 'up' & 4 'down' beads

<u>Please remember:</u> 'up' beads come either from the loop on your left hand, from the ball, or from the left hand shuttle; 'down' beads are ALWAYS – ALWAYS from the shuttle in your right hand.
