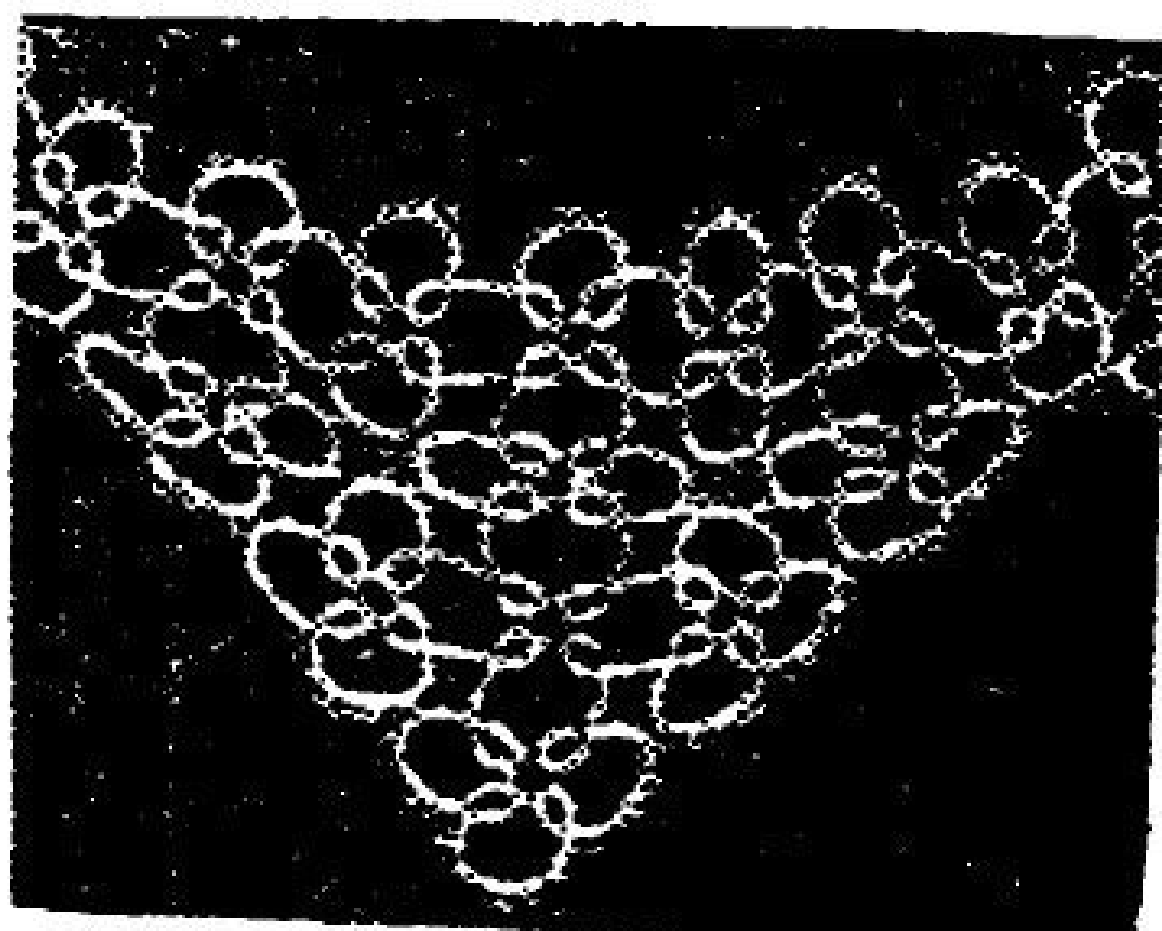


TATTING YOKE

PATTERN WINS \$2.

A very pretty yoke in tatting is made as follows:

Commence at lower point of scallop with a r. of 8 ds, p, 2 ds, p, 8 ds, close; ch 2 ds, (p, 2 ds) 10 times. R, join by first p to last p of preceding r, ch of (2 ds, p) 8 times, 8 ds, r, join by first p to second p of last r. Ch 8 ds, r. (all rings are made the same way). ch of 8 ds, r. ch 8 ds, join to last p



of preceding long chain. (2 ds, p) 8 times, 2 ds, r. join as before to preceding r, ch (2 ds, p) 8 times, 2 ds, r, join as before to preceding r.

Ch 8 ds, p. (2 ds, p) 4 times, 8 ds,
