ch- chain, r - ring, p - picot, j - join, rw - reverse work

ch 5

r 4 p 4 p 4 p 4

\*ch 4 p 4

r 4 j 4 p 4 p 4(to last p of previous r)

Rep from \* til there are 7 rings

ch 4 p 4 p 4 p 4 This is the inside corner

+ r 4 p 4 j 4 p 4(to middle p of previous ring)

ch 4 p 4

r 4 j 4 p 4 p 4(to last p of previous r)

ch 4 p 4

r 4 j 4 p 4 p 4(to last p of previous r)

ch 2

r 2 j 2 p 2 p 2(to last picot of prev r)

ch 2

r 4 j 4 p 2 lp 2 p 4 p 4(to last picot of prev r)

Tie beginning and ending with an overhand knot, cut 2 inches from end for a tassel

Take a 24 inch thread and double it, put it through the top picot of the cross and twist into a rope ending with an overhand knot

r 2 j 2 p 2 p 2(to last picot of prev r)

ch 2

r 4 j 4 p 4 p 4(to last picot of prev r)

ch 4 p 4

r 4 j 4 p 4 p 4(to last p of previous r)

ch 4 p 4

ch 4 j(to last p on long ch) 4 p 4 p 4

Repeat from + to +

ch 4 j(to last p on long ch) 4 p 4 p 4

Repeat from + to +

ch 4 j(to last p on long ch) 4 p 4 j(to first picot on first long chain) 4

r 4 p 4 j(to middle p of prev ring) 4 p 4

#ch 4 j 4 (to p on corresponding chain)

r 4 j 4 p 4 p 4(to last p of previous r)

Repeat from # 5 times
