

Christmas Lights Necklace



Materials:

- McCall's Ribbon Floss
 - 1 spool each – Gold Shimmer
 - Evergreen Shimmer
- 1 package "Dress It Up" buttons – "Jack Frost" (Christmas tree lights)
- One Christmas Charm or miniature Christmas Ornament
- 1 gold lobster claw, or other clasp
- 2 medium gold split jump rings
- 1 large gold split jump ring
- 2 shuttles

Note:

Join to a bulb or a charm (jump ring) as you would to a button.

Preparation:

Attach a medium split jump ring to small hole of clasp. Attach a medium split jump ring to charm and then attach large split jump ring to the previous jump ring. Wind gold Ribbon Floss onto S1 (very full) and green onto S2 (full).

- Ring A: $7 \pm (C1)4-3$.
- Ring B: $3+(A2)8-3$.
- Ring C: $3+(B1)4-7$.
- chain a: $14+(\text{bulb/charm})14$.

The above pattern is repeated throughout, using the following color sequence for bulbs: red, purple, blue, green, yellow, (charm), yellow, green, blue, purple, red, and ending with a repeat of Rings A-C after the second yellow bulb. Cut, attach, tie, hide, but DO NOT trim ends close yet.

** Wind 2 shuttles (2 yards EACH) CTM with gold ribbon floss.

- Ring D: $7+(A1)7$.
- Split Ring E: $7/7$.

Repeat Split Ring E, 9 more times, or until piece from charm to last split ring measures half the desired finished length of necklace minus 1 inch.

- Ring F: $7+(\text{jump ring with clasp})7$.

Cut, attach, tie, hide.

Repeat from ** for other side of necklace, joining Ring D to C1, making the same number of rings, and joining Ring F to the other jump ring.
