



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This cross was made with Lizbeth 80 thread in Spring Green and Wildflower Garden using 2 shuttles. Along with 2 other crosses it won a first place at the Maricopa County Fair 4-13-2011.

Abbreviations: r = ring, sr = small ring, lr = large ring, ch = chain, lch = long chain, rw = reverse work, DNRW = do not reverse work, - = picot, -- = long picot, + = join, s/r = split ring. prev = previous, SS = switch shuttles, s1 = shuttle 1, s2 = shuttle 2

Begin at the top approximately 20" from the end of thread on shuttle 2 and 15" from the end of shuttle 2 with ch 4 using s2 as the working shuttle, DNRW SS.



Before the last s/r cut the s2 thread about 16" from the last chain
 s/r 4+4-2/2-4+4 (+ last - prev sr and + to first - of first sr). Carry the 15" length of s2
 along with core thread on the first side of the s/r. Form the unflipped double stitches on
 the second half with the 20" length from s1 finger tatting and carrying the 16" thread
 from s2. Try to remember to use a magic thread through the entire second half of the sr.
 When you close the ring use the magic thread to pull the last thread end so that it comes
 out at the same place as the other 3 threads. Tie all of them with an overhand knot.
 Separate the different colors, 2 threads in each hand. Twist the right hand away from you
 and left toward you until tight. Gently bring them together so they form a little rope and tie
 another overhand knot. Trim the ends of the thread about 3/4" for a little tassel. Block
 and let dry.



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
