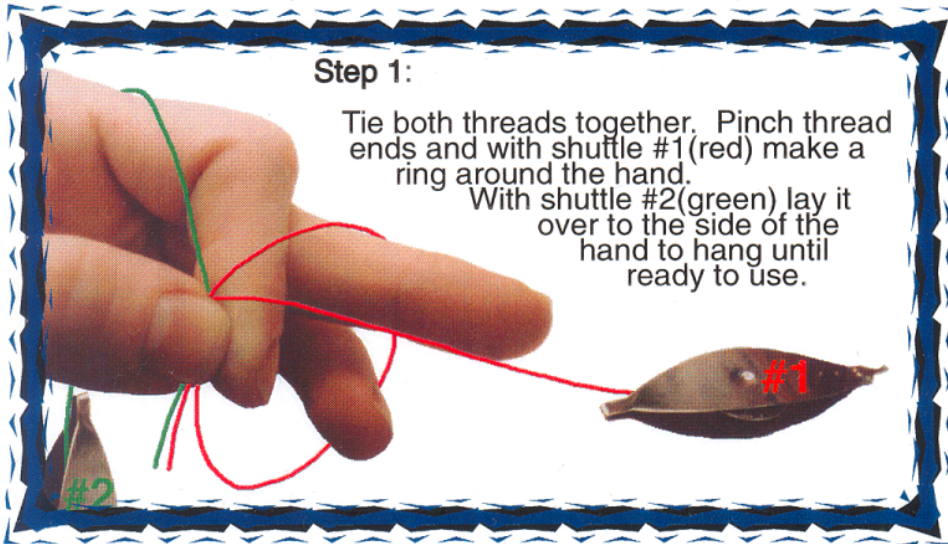


Making the Daisy Picot Ring

(shuttle directions - as inspired by Gale Marshall's online instructions)

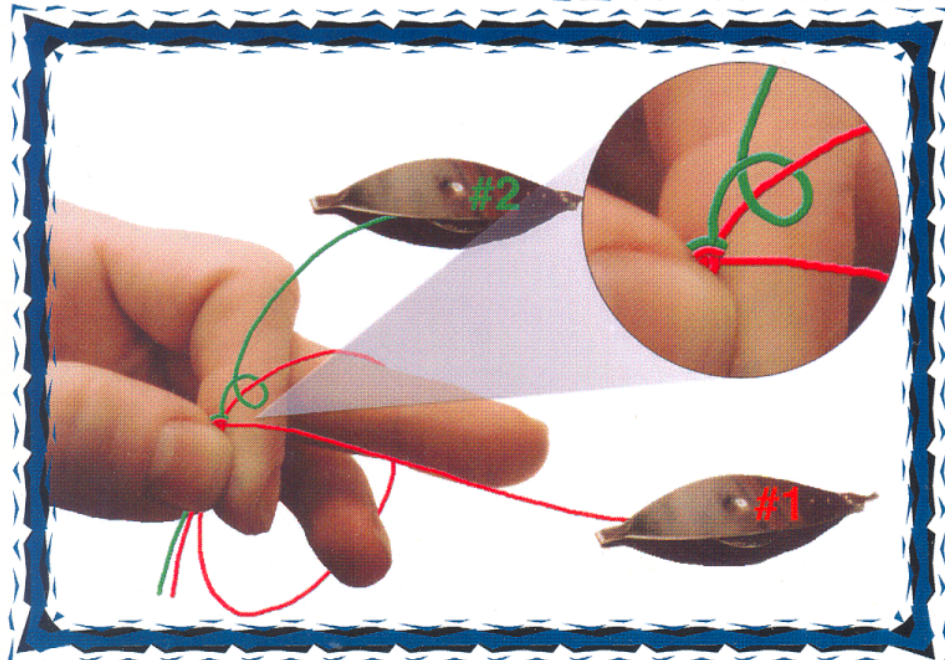
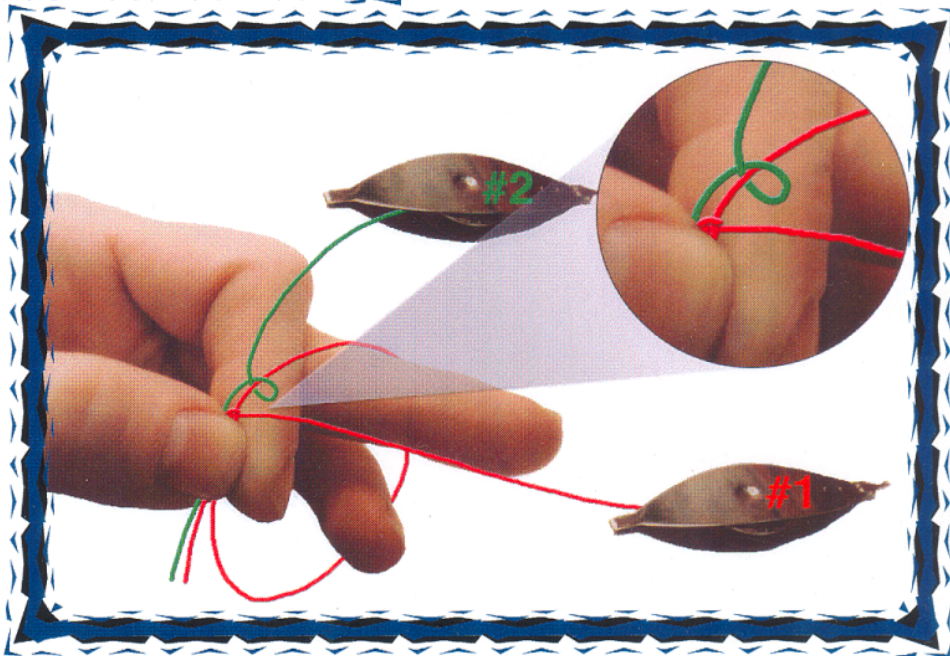
Step 1:

Tie both threads together. Pinch thread ends and with shuttle #1 (red) make a ring around the hand.
With shuttle #2 (green) lay it over to the side of the hand to hang until ready to use.



Step 2:

Drop sh#1 and pick up sh#2. Using the working thread (red) as the core thread, make an unflipped 1st half hitch of a double stitch with sh#2 (as you would when making a split ring).



Step 3:

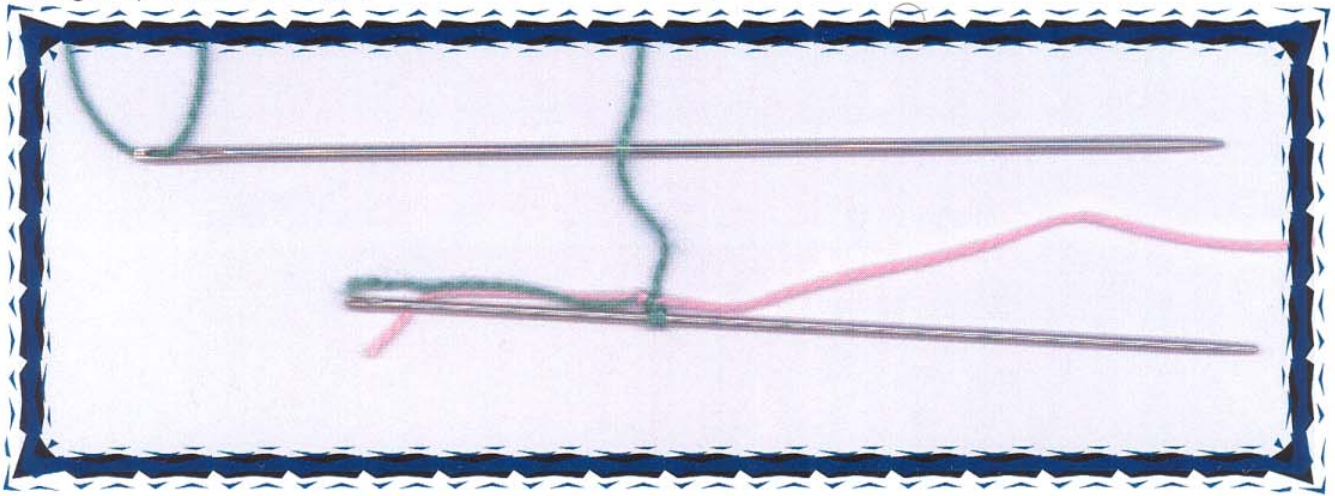
Make second half of double stitch with sh#2 (green), unflipped. From there you can add more double stitches to the daisy picot or alternate from shuttle to shuttle to get varying looks to the ring. The next page will show you several ways to use this technique.

Making the Daisy Picot Ring

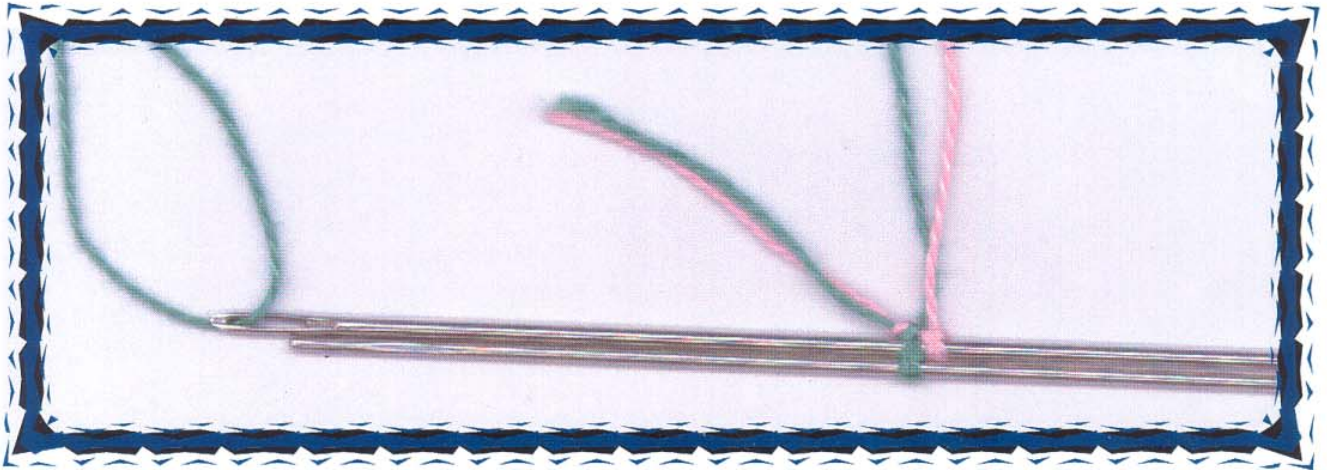
Step 1:

Tie thread ends together. Thread needle #1 with green. With unthreaded needle #2 make a ds with green thread tight up to the tied ends.



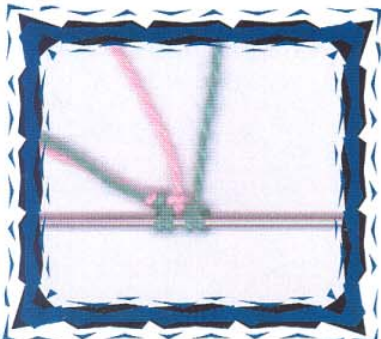
Step 2:

Slide needle #1 behind needle #2 and the ds you just made. Make a ds with pink thread on needle #1.



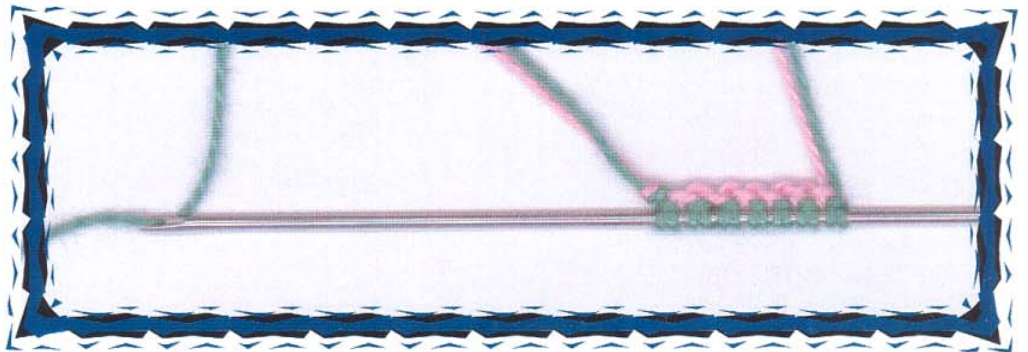
Step 3:

Pull green thread through with needle #1. Snug the pink ds up tight to the green ds. Make another ds with the green thread on needle #2



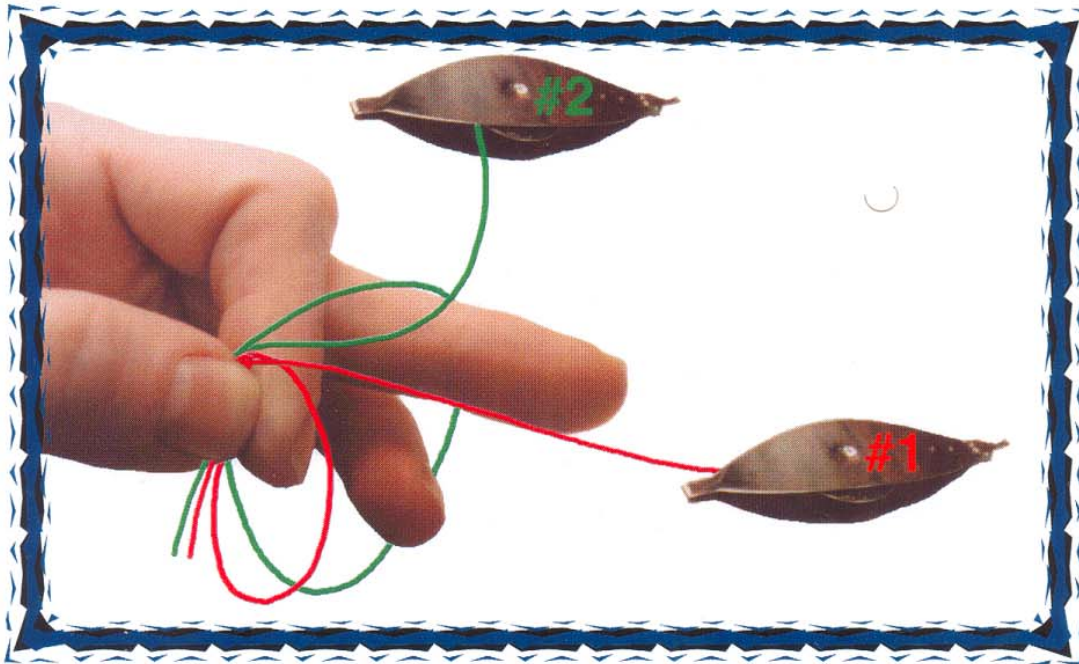
Step 4:

Continue on with the double row of ds for desired number. Unthread needle #1 and thread the green on to needle #2. Pull thread through to make the ring complete.



Throwing a Ring off of the Daisy Picot Thread (shuttle directions)

To make a ring off of the Daisy Picot Thread (DPT), drop the ring of thread around the hand and take shuttle #2 and form a ring around hand as you would in making a ring. Make a ring of desired number of stitches and close ring. Regroup main ring thread from shuttle #1 around hand and continue on with DPR.



Throwing a Ring off of the Daisy Picot Thread (needle directions)

In this case the DPR is 3 ds with the green with the Daisy Picot Thread (DPT) making a picot with a space of thread using 1ds. To throw a ring off of the DPT, unthread needle #1 and rethread with pink. Make desired number of ds and picots. Pull pink thread through and form ring. Rethread needle #1 with green and slide needle #1 behind needle #2 and green thread and make ds with pink thread, leaving an appropriate amount of space of thread. Pull green thread through pink ds and then make ds with green thread on needle #2. Continue on with the remainder of DPR.
