REMEMBER THE NAME

BUCILLA!!

CHAIN STITCH

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Put thread over hook, forming a loop on hook * thread over, pull thread through loop on hook, repeat from * for the desired length

SLIP STITCH

Make a ch. the length required, skip 1 ch., insert hook in next ch. thread over hook and pull thread through the ch. and the loop on hook.

SINGLE CROCHET

Make a ch., skip 1 ch. insert hook in next ch., thread over hook and pull thread through ch. thus giving 2 loops on hook, thread over and through the two loops.

DOUBLE STATE OF STREET CROCHET

Make a ch., thread over hook, skip 3 ch., insert hook in fourth ch., pull thread through ch., thread over, through 2 loops, thread over through 2 loops.

TREBLE CROCHET

Make a ch., thread over twice, skip 4 ch., insert hook in fifth ch., pull thread through ch., thread over, through 2 loops, thread over through two loops, again thread over through 2.

PICOT EDGE

Three s. c. on ch., ch. 4, insert hook from top downward through 2 threads of last s. c., thread over through all 3 loops on hook.

FILET CROCHET. Make a ch. the length required having a multiple of 3 ch. Skip first 8 ch., 1 d. c. in next ch., thus forming the first mesh or sp., * ch. 2, skin 2 ch., 1 d. c. in next, repeat from * for sp. desired. Turn work. If next row begins with an open mesh or sp. ch. 5, 1 d. c. in second d. c. of previous row, * ch. 2, 1 d. c. in next d. c., repeat from * Closed sp. or blocks are worked as follows: ch. 3 at end of row to count as the first d. c. or block, make 1 d. c. in each of next 2 ch. of first sp., 1 d. c. in next d. c.


Roll all edges to dotted lines. On neck and sleeves of gown, neck and armsize of combination, and neck and arm-size of corset cover, work the full width having beading for ribbon. Down the front of corset cover and around the lower edge of combination work a narrow edge which is a repetition of the First, Third and Final rows.

First Row: work over rolled edges firmly and evenly with s. c. Second Row: 1 d. tr. (thread over 4 times to form a double treble), * ch. 1,

thread over hook 4 times, pick up 2nd s. c., thread over, through 2, thread over, through 2, thread over hook twice, skip 3 s. c., thread over and through 2 six times, ch. 3, 1 d. c. through centre of stitches below (forming a cross tr.), ch. 1, skip 1 s. c., 1 d. tr., and repeat from * all around.

Third Row: 1 s. c. on cross tr., * ch. 5, skip 3, 1 s. c., and repeat from *.

Final Row: 1 s. c. in 1st loop, * 1 d. c. in next loop, 1 p., repeat from * until there are 4 p., then begin again with 1 s. c. and repeat all around.

Twentieth Row: ch. 8, 1 p., turn, ch. 2, 1 s. c. in next sp., * 1 p. loop, sl. st. to fifth petal, and repeat 3 times from °, ch. 2, 1 p., ch. 2, 1 s. c. in 1st sp. of Fifteenth row.

Twenty-first Row: ch. 8, turn, 1 s. c. in twenty-nest Row: ch. 8, turn, 1 s. c. in next 8p, ch. 5, 1 s. c. before p. of next sp., ch. 8, 1 p., ch. 2, 1 s. c. between p. of same sp., 1 p. loop, 1 s. c. in next sp., and repeat from twice. Repeat from Sixth row until 3 roses have been incorporated in the strip. Then finish sides of Insertion with s. c. and p.

Edging for Cap: is the same as Twelfth round of Medallion, but is crocheted firmly and evenly over the rolled edges of the cap material.







Edging, First Round: * 1 s. c., ch. 4, skip 4, and repeat from * all around.
Second Round: 1 s. c. in loop, * 2 d. c.,

1 p., 2 d. c., 1 p., 2 d. c., 1 p., 2 d. c. in next loop, 1 s. c. in next loop, and repeat from *.

The finished motif, a lion rampant on a shield, may be mounted upon scrim or net for any size door.







2 balls BUCILLA Crochet Cotton, Art. 063, Size 30; BUCILLA Crochet Hook No. 10.

Cut parasol on dotted lines, sew sections together with French seams, and make a narrow machine hem all around edge. First Round: work with s. c. firmly and closely all around.

Second Round: 1 s. c. in 3 s. c., taking up back of st., * ch. 4, catch back to last s. c. with a sl. st. to form p., 1 s, c. in next 3 s. c., and repeat from *. Third Round: sl. st. to centre of 1st p., ch. 3 (to count as 1 d. c.), 2 more d. c. in same p., * ch. 3, skip 1 p., 3 d. c. in next p., and repeat from *. Fourth Round: 1 s. c. in centre of loop sp., * ch. 7, 1 s. c. in next loop, and repeat from *.

Fifth Round: * 5 s. c., ch. 4, catch back with sl. st. to last s. c. (to form a p.), 5 s. c. (all in 7 ch. loop), and repeat from *.

Cap: ch. 24 and join to form a ring. 1 s. c. on each ch. repeated for 18 rounds. Nineteenth Round: 1 s. c. in 1 s. c., * 2 s. c. in next s. c., 1 s. c. in next s. c., and repeat from *.

Twenty-first Round: 1 s. c. in s. c., 1 p., and repeat from *.

Twenty-second Round: 3 d. c. in p., * ch. 3, skip 1 p., 3 d. c. in next p., and repeat from *.

Twenty-third Round: 1 s. c. in 2nd ch. of sp., * ch. 5, 1 s. c. in 2nd ch. of sp., * ch. 5, 1 s. c. in 2nd ch. of next sp., and repeat from *.

Twenty-fourth Round: * 3 s. c., 1 p., 3 s. c., and repeat from * in each sp.

5 balls BUCILLA Crochet Cotton, Art. 063, Size 50; BUCILLA Crochet Hook No. 12; Finishes 18 inches in diameter.

Having crocheted according to chart, work the following edge:
First Round: make a band of ch. catching into the points of the filet. In order to set well some ch. between points will be 3 st. and some will be 6.
Second Row: 10 s. c., * ch. 7, sl. st. back into 6th s. c., ch. 1, 2 s. c. in

loop, 1 p. of 3 ch., 2 s. c. in loop, ch. 8, sl. st. into 1st s. c., — ch. 1, 2 s. c., 1 p., 2 s. c., 1 p., 2 s. c. in loop, 2 s. c., 1 p., 2 s. c. in loop, 2 s. c., 1 p., 2 s. c. in 1st loop, 4 s. c. in ch., ch. 8, sl. st. back on top of small loop, repeat from *, 13 s. c. in ch., and repeat from *.

FILET SCARF No. 303

6 balls BUCILLA Crochet Cotton, Art. 063, Size 50; BUCILLA Crochet Hook No. 12; Finishes 18 inches wide.

The strips for the sides of scarf are to be worked as long as may be desired.

When completed mount on linen, and make 6 medium sized tassels.

Insertion: work First, Second, Third and Fourth rows as for Yoke, and work the Fifth row given for yoke twice on each side of belt beading.

Cube: ch. 11, skip 2 from hook, * 9 s. c., ch. 2, turn and repeat from * for 9 rows. Then work all around square

TATTING LESSON FOR BEGINNERS

Beginners can learn more easily with a fairly coarse thread and the best results are attained by using BUCILLA Shuttle No. 135, size 4, and BUCILLA Tatting Cottons. Be sure the shuttle is closed at both ends and makes a clicking sound when winding. Also be careful not to spring the shuttle by filling too full of thread.

Wind by inserting thread through the hole in shank of shuttle, tie in with double knot and revolve the shuttle, being sure the ends remain closed.

Taking thread between thumb and first finger, pass it around all the fingers of the left hand, spreading first and second fingers widely apart. Hold shuttle with first finger and thumb as lightly as possible, finger on top and thumb under shuttle. (The thread should always be on the outside of shuttle, toward the hand.) Raise shuttle thread over little finger of right hand, pass shuttle under finger thread (see Fig. 1)

and back over between finger thread and shuttle thread, letting thread slip between the fingers and the shuttle, give shuttle a quick pull, at the sametime dropping the middle finger of left hand (keeping the shuttle thread tight), and raise middle finger of left hand, thus forming one-half of double stitch (see Fig. 2). For the sec-



ond half, shuttle is passed over and back under finger thread while middle finger of left hand is lowered (see Fig.



The shuttle thread should pull easily if the stitches are tied correctly, but if they are tied with shuttle thread in-stead of finger thread they will knot and prevent rings from being drawn up. To make a picot (see Fig. 5), work first
