
Philly Frost Snowflake Noo Bear

Size 20 Thread

Abbreviations

R = Ring	+ = Join
CH = Chain	DNRW = Do not reverse work
SS = Swap shuttles	RW = Reverse work
- = Picot

Size 20 thread 2 shuttles

This snowflake is worked in one round. You will need 2 shuttles wound CTM

RC:
$$1 + (to ring B) 2 - 2 - 2 - 2 - 2 - 3 RW$$

RE: 1 + (to ring D)
$$1-1-1-1-1-2$$
 RW

Clover

RG:
$$2 + (to ring F) 6 - 2 - 2 - 2 - 2 - 6 - 2 DNRW$$

RH:
$$2 + (to ring G) 2 - 2 - 2 - 2 - 2 - 4 RW$$

RJ: 1 + (to ring I) 1 - 1 - 1 - 1 - 1 - 2 RW

CH: 1 + (to adjacent chain) 7 + (to adjacent chain) 14 DNRW

SS

RK: 3-2-2-3+ (to ring A) 3-3-2-2-3 RW

RL: 3 – 2 – 2 – 2 – 2 – 1 DNRW

RM: 1 + (to ring L) 2 - 2 - 2 - 2 - 2 - 3 RW *

Repeat from * to * until you have 6 points.

NOTE: The repeat for each point is the same except for ring Z. Work ring Z as follows:

RZ:
$$3-2-2-3+$$
 (to ring Y) $3+$ (to ring A) $3-2-2-3-$

After working the final point and the last chain of 14, cut and tie to the base of Ring A.
