



Make Do Flat Shuttle

I made a flat shuttle from an old AAA membership card. It is a little bit soft...I recommend an old outdated/cancelled credit card. The open circle is a bit close to the "top". If I had a single hole punch that would have worked better but I had to use a 3 hole punch and that is where the circle came out. It does work reasonably well. The tail was both sides of a corner with the center "V'd" out. The blue card is 6 inches long. **I recommend purchasing a flat shuttle from Georgia Seitz (www.georgiaseitz.com)** but this works at least it is usable (it won't last...too soft and gets softer with use). I have ordered one of the nice wood flat shuttles from Georgia.

This shuttle will easily hold 11 yards of size 10 crochet thread. There are 80 beads spaced throughout the length of the thread in groups of 10—when I put it back on the shuttle...I could not get it to scan with the thread on the shuttle.
