### A-433 Tatted Edging

J. & P. COATS "BIG BALL" BEST SIX CORD  
MERCERIZED CROCHET, Size 30; or

CLARK'S "BIG BALL" MERCERIZED CROCHET,  
Size 30.

Tatting shuttle.

Edging measures about ½ inch wide.

With ball and shuttle threads, r of 4 ds, 3 p's sep by 4 ds, 4 ds and cl. Rw, ch of 6 ds, sm p, 14 ds. \* Rw, r of 8 ds, join to center p of previous r, 8 ds and cl. Rw, ch of 14 ds, sm p, 6 ds. Rw, r of 4 ds, p, 4 ds and cl. Reversing curve of chain, ch of 4 ds, p, 4 ds. R of 4 ds, 3 p's sep by 4 ds, 4 ds and cl. Rw, ch of 6 ds, join to sm p of next-to-last ch, 14 ds. Repeat from \* for length desired. Tie and cut. Press lightly. Sew in place.

### A-434 Tatted Edging

Size 50.

Tatting shuttle.

Edging measures about ¾ inch wide.

With ball and shuttle, r of 11 ds, p, 8 ds, sm p, 3 ds and cl. \* R of 3 ds, join to sm p of previous r, 8 ds, p, 8 ds, sm p, 3 ds and cl. R of 3 ds, join to sm p of previous r, 8 ds, p, 11 ds and cl—cluster made. Rw, ch of 17 ds, join to last p of last r, 18 ds. Rw, r of 8 ds, sm p, 3 ds, p, 11 ds and cl. Rw, ch of 17 ds, join to p of previous r. Rw, r of 3 ds, join to sm p of previous cluster, 8 ds, sm p, 3 ds and cl. R of 3 ds, join to last sm p of previous

r, 8 ds, p, 11 ds and cl. Rw, ch of 10 ds. Rw, r of 11 ds, join to last p of previous r, 8 ds, sm p, 3 ds and cl. Repeat from \* for desired length. Tie and cut. Press lightly. Sew in place.

### A-435 Tatted Edging

J. & P. COATS "BIG BALL" BEST SIX CORD  
MERCERIZED CROCHET, Size 50; or

CLARK'S "BIG BALL" MERCERIZED CROCHET,  
Size 50.

Tatting shuttle.

Edging measures about 1¼ inches wide.

With ball and shuttle threads, r of 3 ds, 6 p's sep by 3 ds, 3 ds and cl. \* Rw, ch of 3 ds, 10 p's sep by 3 ds, 3 ds. Rw, sp of ¼ inch. R of 3 ds, 9 p's sep by 3 ds, 3 ds and cl. (R of 3 ds, join to last p of previous r, 3 ds, 8 p's sep by 3 ds, 3 ds and cl) 3 times, joining last p of last r to first p of first r of 4-r group. Rw, ch of 3 ds, join to last p of previous ch, 3 ds, 9 p's sep by 3 ds, 3 ds. Rw, r of 3 ds, 6 p's sep by 3 ds, 3 ds and cl. Repeat from \* for desired length. Rw, ch of 3 ds, 12 p's sep by 3 ds, 3 ds. Turn and working along opposite side, \*\* rw, r of 4 ds, join to 2nd p of same r, 6 ds, p, 4 ds, join to center p of adjacent r on next 4-r group, 6 ds and cl. Rw, ch of 3 ds, join to last p of previous ch, 3 ds, 4 p's sep by 3 ds, 3 ds, join to center p of next r of same group, ch of 3 ds, 9 p's sep by 3 ds, 3 ds, join to center p of next r of same group, ch of 3 ds, 5 p's sep by 3 ds, 3 ds. Rw, r of 6 ds, join to center p of next r of same group, 4 ds, p, 6 ds, join to next-to-last p of adjacent r, 4 ds and cl. Rw, ch of 3 ds, join to last p of previous ch, 3 ds, 2 p's sep by 3 ds, 3 ds. Repeat from \*\* across, ending with r. Rw, ch of 3 ds, join to last p of previous ch, 3 ds, 11 p's sep by 3 ds, 3 ds. Join at base of first r. Tie and cut. Press lightly. Sew in place.

### A-436 Tatted Edging

J. & P. COATS "BIG BALL" BEST SIX CORD  
MERCERIZED CROCHET, Size 30; or

CLARK'S "BIG BALL" MERCERIZED CROCHET,  
Size 30.

2 Tatting shuttles.

Edging measures about 2 inches wide.

FIRST MOTIF . . . 1st rnd: Using 2 shuttles, tie threads together, with first shuttle, r of 3 ds, 3 p's sep by 3 ds, 3 ds and cl. (Rw, ch of 5 ds, p, 5 ds. Rw, r of 3 ds, p, 3 ds, join to center p of previous r, 3 ds, p, 3 ds and cl) 3 times. Rw, ch as before, joining at base of first r. 2nd rnd: \* Ch of 10 ds. Rw, r of 3 ds, p, 3 ds, join to p of first ch of previous rnd, 3 ds, p, 3 ds and cl. Drop first shuttle. Pick up 2nd shuttle, rw, r of 3 ds, 3 p's sep by 3 ds, 3 ds and cl. Drop 2nd shuttle, pick up first shuttle. Ch as before, join at base of next r. Repeat from \* around. Tie and cut.

SECOND MOTIF . . . 1st rnd: Tie threads together, work exactly as for first rnd of previous motif. 2nd rnd: Ch of 10 ds. Rw, r of 3 ds, p, 3 ds, join to center p of 3rd r of 2nd rnd of previous motif, 3 ds, p, 3 ds and cl. Complete motif as before, no more joinings.

THIRD MOTIF . . . Work exactly as for Second Motif, joining Third Motif to Second Motif as Second Motif was joined to First Motif. Continue to work this way for desired length. Now work around motifs as follows: Using ball and shuttle threads, tie threads together, r of 3 ds, p, 3 ds, join to joint p of First Motif, 3 ds, p, 3 ds and cl. Rw, ch of 12 ds and join between 2nd and 3rd chs of 2nd rnd of same motif. \* Ch of 12 ds, join to first p of 4th r of same motif, 6 ds, join to center p of same r, 6 ds, join to last p of same r, 12 ds, join between next 2 chs, ch of 13 ds. Rw, r of 3 ds, p, 3 ds, join to joint p between motif, 3 ds, p, 3 ds

and cl. Rw, ch as before, joining between 2nd and 3rd chs of next motif. Repeat from \* across ending with r. Tie and cut. Tie ball and shuttle threads together, working along opposite side of motifs. R of 3 ds, p, 3 ds, join to joint p of last motif directly opposite of last r, 3 ds, p,

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
