

" Old Fashioned Heart "

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General: a simple heart....lots of possibilities! The only thing you need to watch out for is that you join at the correct picots. The first round will give you the heart shape,, the second round completes it. There are some partial photos to lead you along:

Row 1:

You need two shuttles wound continuously!

Or two shuttles if working with two colors.

Begin at the ring where the hand points. Shuttle 2 rings are NOT numbered!



- R1: 2-2-2-2-2-2. rw
- CH: 3. SS
- R: 3-3.(make this a small picot)

- CH: 3. rw
- R2: 2+(to 4th picot of previous Ring) 2-2-2-2-2. rw
- CH: 3, SS, R: 3-3., SS, 3. rw
- R3: 2+(to 4th picot of previous Ring) 2-2-2-2-2. rw
- CH: 3, SS, R: 3-3., SS, 6. rw
- R4: 3 +(to 4th picot of previous ring) 3. rw
- CH: 6, SS, R: 3-3, SS, 3. rw
- R5: 2-2+ (join into same picot as previous join) 2 +(to 3rd picot of ring three)2-2-2. rw
- CH: 3, SS, R: 3-3., SS, 3. rw

- R6: 2-2 + (to 5th picot of previous ring) 2-2-2-2.rw
- CH: 3, SS, R: 3-3., SS, 3. rw
- R7: 2-2 + (to 5th picot of previous ring) 2-2-2-2.rw
- CH: 3. rw
- R8: 2-2 + (to 5th picot of previous ring) 2-2-2-2.rw
- CH: 3. rw
- R9: 2 +(to last picot of previous ring) 2-2-2-2-2. rw
- CH: 3. rw
- R10: same as last ring
- CH: 3. rw
- R11: same as last ring
- CH: 3 + (to picot in opposite shuttle2 ring) 3. rw
- R12: 2-2 + (to 5th picot of last ring) 2-2-2-2. rw
- CH: 3+3. rw
- R13: same as last ring.
- CH: 3+3. rw
- R14: same as last ring.
- CH: 3, SS, R: 3-3. (very small picot) ss, 3. rw
- R15: 2 +(to 5th picot of previous ring) 2-2-2-2-2. rw
- CH: 3. rw
- R16: (bottom center) 2 +(to 5th picot of previous ring) 3-3-3-3-2. rw
- CH: 3. rw.
- R17: 2 +(to 5th picot of previous ring) 2-2-2-2-2. rw
- CH: 3, SS, [R:3+(to picot of last shuttle 2 ring) 3], SS, 3. rw
- R18: 2 +(to 5th picot of last ring) 2-2-2-2-2. rw
- CH: 3 +(to picot of opposite shuttle2 ring) 3. rw
- R19: 2 + (to 4th (!) picot of previous ring) 2-2-2-2-2. rw
- CH: same as last chain.
- R20: same as last ring
- CH: same as last chain.
- R21: same as last ring.
- CH: 3. rw
- R22: 2 +(to 5th picot of previous ring) 2-2-2-2-2. rw



- CH: 3. rw
- R23: same as previous ring.
- CH: 3. rw
- R24: (last ring) 2+ (to 5th picot of previous ring) 2-2-2 + (to 1st picot of 1st ring)


2-2. rw

yes, this is the twisted join, make sure you have both shuttle threads above the work, for last chain, bend piece backwards!

- CH: 3 . Join into base of first ring, cut, tie and fasten ends.

Row 2:

In this row, there is only one " shuttle2 ring " at the bottom point of the heart. So if you are tatting with a small ball of thread, you don't need to wind it on a second shuttle but can just form the ring with the ball in your hand. Alternatively, if you are only using one color, do the shoelace trick to work the small ring at the bottom. (shoelace = make an overhand knot to bring your shuttle to the other side, tat the ring, make another knot to bring shuttle back and continue).



-R1: 6 + (to 2nd picot of ring in previous row) 3 + (to 3rd picot of next ring of previous row) 6. rw

The first ring of row 2 attaches to the 2nd picot of ring 20 of row 1, after 3 ds, you attach to the next available picot of the next ring of row one (ring 19).

-CH: 2-2-2-2. rw

-R2: 6 + (to next picot on same ring of row 1) 3 + (to next picot of next ring of row 1) 6 . rw

-CH: same as before

-R3: 6 + (join into the next TWO available picots of row 1: put your hook through both picots and pull thread through) 3 +(to next picot on row 1) 6. rw

-CH: same as before

-R4: 6 +(to next available picot of row 1) 3 + (to next picot on next ring of row 1) 6. rw

-CH: 2-2-2-2-2. rw.

-R5: (bottom center ring) 4-5 +(to center picot on bottom center ring of row 1) 5-4. rw

- small ring: either use shuttle 2, your ballthread or use shoelace trick: R: 2+(to last picot of previous chain) 2-2-2-2-2. SS

-CH: 2 +(to last picot of last ring) 2-2-2-2. rw

-R6: 6 +(to next picot on center ring of row 1) 3 +(to next available picot) 6. rw

-CH: 2-2-2-2. rw

-R7: 6 + (to next available picot) 3 +(join into the next TWO available picots of row 1)

6. rw

-CH: same as before

-R8: 6 +(to next picot) 3 +(to next picot) 6. rw

-CH: same as before

-R9: 6 + (to next picot) 3 +(to next picot) 6. rw

-CH: same as before

-R10: 6 +(join into the next TWO available picots of row 1) 3 +(to next picot) 6. rw

-CH: same

-R11: 7 +(skip one picot and join into the the next one which is on the next ring of row
1) 7. rw
-CH: same
-R12: 7 +(to next picot) 7. rw
-CH: same
-R13: 7 +(skip one picot and join into the the next one which is on the next ring of row
1) 7. rw
-CH: same
-R14: 7 +(to next picot) 7. rw
-CH: same
-R15: 6 +(to next picot) 3 +(to next picot) 6. rw
-CH: same
-R16: 7 +(to next picot) 7. rw
-CH: same
-R17: 7 +(to next picot) 7. rw
-CH: same
-R18: 5 +(to next picot) 2 (!) +(to next picot) 5. rw
-CH: 3-3. rw
-R19: 4 +(to next picot) 2 +(to next picot) 4. do not rw!
-R20: 4 +(to next picot) 2 +(to next picot) 4. rw
-CH: 3 +(to previous chain) 3. rw -R21: 5 +(to next picot) 2 +(to next picot) 5. rw
-CH: 2-2-2-2. rw
-R22: 7 +(to next picot) 7. rw
continue in this manner orienting yourself of the half of the heart that you have
already tatted. Take care to skip those two picots at the bend. There is one more
doublejoin which is the last ringjoin. At the end, join the last chain into the bast of the
first ring of this row, cut, tie and fasten ends.

SS=switch shuttle

CH=chain

R=ring

rw=reverse work

.=tighten ring, chain

1,2,3,etc.=just numbered rings to find your place in the pattern quicker

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
