## **Jewelry Medallion (Earring)**

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This is a fairly generic motif, where the central rings are curled (Ninetta's Curled Rings). It can be adapted into any jewelry item, with the right hooks, etc.

Materials used : Anchor Mercer Cotton (size 20) Blue : 4054-0131 & Royal Blue : 4054-0133 Pearl Beads – 4 Silver Metallic seed beads – 16 Earring hooks & rings – 2 each Final Mst. of medallion : 11/2" x 3/4"

Abbreviations & notations used :

- Sh shuttle
- R ring
- CI close ring
- B bead
- picot
- + join (where to join is given in brackets)

Preparation : 2 shuttles. Load Sh1 with blue thread & 4 pearl beads Load Sh2 with royal blue thread & 16 silver seed beads (metallic)

## All frontside tatting . Rings are made alternately with each shuttle .

<u>How to Curl a ring</u> : After closing ring, fold the tip over from front. Join to base using a normal picot join, by pulling loop of Sh2 thread, passing Sh1 thru the loop, & tensioning.

For rings made with Sh1 (*central curled rings* – 1,3,5,7), pearl/bead is kept around the hand when starting a ring. {the steps to add bead in curled ring are indicated in above collage image}

For larger rings made with Sh2 (*outer rings* - 2,4,6,8), 3 beads (BBB) are slipped around the hand when starting the ring, & 1 bead (B) is moved up from shuttle thread.

R1 (Sh1) : 6 - 6 - 6 - 6 B . Cl. <u>Curl Ring</u>. R2 (Sh2) : 6 - 12 BBB, **B** 12 - 6. Cl . \*\* R3 (Sh1) : 6 + (thru' R1 & R2 picots **simultaneously**) - 6 - 6 B . Cl . <u>Curl Ring</u>. R4 (Sh2) : 6 + (R2) 12 BBB, B 12 - 6. Cl . \*\* Repeat from \*\* to \*\* 2 more times, to complete 4 rings each (total 8 rings), remembering to join back to the first rings.

Tie, cut & hide ends.

Insert earring hook with ring through the space between any 4 metallic rings. Or choose your favorite method of joining the hook/ring.
