Clover earrings



Joins are indicated with red bars on the diagram.

Those earrigns were inspired by Kersti's *Bumpy* bookmark.

The pictured earrings were made in Lizbeth 20 thread, colorway *Falling leaves* (#100).

Feel free to add beads if you like.

<u>Equipment</u>: one shuttle and ball of your choice of thread, two earring hooks; facultative: beads.

<u>Abbreviations</u>: ring (R) et chain (Ch), picot (-), simple join (+), folded join (for the last join between the rings), return work (RW).

The numbers in the diagram and in the short-hand explanations refer to the number of double stitches.

Pattern:

Start with one of the lateral ring of the top clover.

R: 5 - 10 - 5

Now tat the central ring of the clover.

R: 5 + 15 - 5

Finish the clover with its third ring.

R: 5 + 10 - 5.RW

Ch: 5. RW

R: 5 + 15 - 5. RW

Ch: 5. RW

Clover:

R: 5 + 10 - 5 R: 5 + 15 - 5

R: 5 + 10 - 5.RW

Ch: 5. RW

R: 5 + 15 + (folded join to the 1st ring) 5. RW

Ch: 5. Tie at the base of the 1st ring, and hide threads ends. Attach earrings hook.

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
