

# Simple Dragonfly Earrings Wanda Salmans 2014

\mathrm{R}=\text { ring Ch }=\text { chain } \\
-=\text { picot } \quad-\text { - longer picot } \\
+=\text { join } \quad \text { SS }=\text { switch shuttles } \\
\text { Sht } 1=\text { shuttle } 1 \quad \text { Sht } 2=\text { shuttle } 2 \\
\text { RW }=\text { reverse work }
\end{gathered}
$$



This was made with 2 shuttles but could be done with one shuttle and a ball. Bead is on Sht1 thread

For each earring you will need a split ring, a bead of choice and an earring hook.

Sht1 R 3++3 to split ring. (join to split ring twice) RW SS
Sht2 R 3-2-2--2-2-3 RW SS
Sht1 Ch 20 B* 20
Join to base of rings.

* for shaped beads make sure it is right-side-up for the way it is to be worn and ball thread is on the backside of the bead.
