# Earrings BNL-168a-1 

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Revised for Online tatting class October 2014
For the pair of earrings you need 2 yards of thread and 160 seed beads (for 3 ply metallic thread use seed beads size 15 , for cotton thread $\# \# 20$ or 10 use seed beads size 11). Use ONE shuttle and ball.

## Symbols used through the pattern:

$\mathbf{1 , 2}, 3$... number of double stitches

## $\mathbf{R}$ ring

CH chain

- picot
+ regular join
LJ lock join
- close a ring or shape a chain

RW reverse work

- 1 'up' bead (on knotting thread)
$\therefore 3$ 'up' beads make POINTED picot
® 2 'up' beads and 1 'down' bead make TRILLIUM picot

¿ 2 'up' beads and 2 'down' beads make a 'block' of beads


## ¿¿ 8 'up' beads make long FLAT TOP picot

'UP' beads come either from the loop on your left hand, from the ball, or from the left hand shuttle; 'DOWN' beads are ALWAYS-ALWAYS from the shuttle in your right hand.

## Pattern for ONE Earring:


2) $\mathrm{R}: 1 \because 1 \because 1-1 \circ 1 \because 1 . \mathrm{RW} 8 / \mathbf{6}^{*}$
3) $\mathrm{CH}: 1^{\circ} 1^{\circ} 1^{\circ} 1^{\circ} 1^{\circ} 1^{\circ} 1^{\circ} 1^{\circ} 1^{\circ} 1^{\circ}{ }^{\circ} 1^{\circ} 1^{\circ} 1^{\circ} 1 . \mathrm{RW}$
4) R: $1 \circ 1^{\circ \circ} 1+$ (to R2) $1 \circ 1 \circ 1^{\circ} 1$.RW $8 / 6^{*}$
5) $\mathrm{CH}: 1^{\circ} 1^{\circ} 1^{\circ} 1^{\circ}{ }^{\circ} 1^{\circ} 1^{\circ} 1^{\circ} 1^{\circ} 1^{\circ} 1^{\circ} 1^{\circ} 1^{\circ} 1^{\circ} 1$.LJ between R1 \& R2.

Tie the tails and hide them inside beads.


* Numbers $16 / 6$ or $8 / 6$ at the end of notation lines for rings mean:
$\mathbf{1 6}$ or $\mathbf{8}$ are 'UP' beads (they have to be placed on the left hand loop BEFORE starting the ring) and $\mathbf{6}$ are 'DOWN' beads (pushed from the right hand shuttle as you go).
