DS double stitch

R ring

CH chain

- picot

+ join

CL close ring

RW reverse work

SJ shuttle join

Ring A (RA) 3 - 3 - 3 - 3 - 3 - 3 - 3, CL, RW

Petal 1 (P1):

Ch 6, RW

R of 3 - 3 - 5, CL, RW

Ch 3 - 3 - 3 - 3 - 3 - 3, SJ (to 2nd picot of previous ring) make an extra small (tiny) picot, 6, SJ (to next free picot of Ring A)

Petal 2 (P2):

Ch 6+(to extra small tiny picot), RW

R of 3 - 3 - 5, CL, RW

Ch 3 - 3 - 3 - 3 - 3 - 3, SJ (to 2nd picot of previous ring) make an extra small (tiny) picot, 6, SJ (to next free picot of Ring A)

Petal 3 (P3):

Ch 6+(to extra small tiny picot), RW

R of 3 - 3 - 5, CL, RW

Ch 3+ (to last free picot of previous petal) 3 - 3 - 3 - 3 - 3, SJ (to 2nd picot of previous ring) make an extra small (tiny) picot, 6, SJ (to next free picot of Ring A)

Petal 4 (P4):

Ch 6+(to last free picot of previous connecting chain), RW

R of 3 - 3 - 5, CL, RW

Ch 3+ (to last free picot of previous petal) 3 - 3 - 3 - 3 - 3, SJ (to 2nd picot of previous

ring) make an extra small (tiny) picot, 6, SJ (to next free picot of Ring A)

Connecting chain 1 (CC1):

Ch 6+ (to extra small tiny picot) 9-6, RW

Connecting chain 2 (CC2):

Ch 6+ (to extra small tiny picot) 9-6, SJ to next free picot of next Ring A

1st flower (1st half): RA, P1, P2 (twice), CC1

2nd flower (1st half): RA, P3, P2 (twice), CC1

3rd flower (1st half): Repeat 2nd flower

Center flower: RA, P3, CC1,

Left flower: RA, P4, P2 (6 times), CC2

Center flower: P4, CC1,

Top Flower: Repeat Left flower

Center flower: P4, CC1

Right flower: Repeat Left flower

Center flower: P4, CC2

3rd flower (2nd half): P4, P2 (twice), CC2

2nd flower (2nd half): Repeat 3rd flower (2nd half)

1st flower (2nd half): P4, P2 (2 times)

Last petal:

Ch 6, RW, R 3 - 3 - 5, CL, RW, 3+(to the extra small tiny picot) 3 - 3 - 3 - 3 - 3 + (to the base of the small ring instead of the extra small tiny picot), SJ (to 2nd picot of previous ring), Ch 6 (join to base of initial ch 6). Cut, tie and hide ends.
