Hearts on a Paper Clip

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Material: Size 20 thread wind on 1 shuttle in CTM, 1 large paper clip.



Version 1

<u>Note</u>: The 8 long picots (---) are about $\frac{1}{2}$ " horizontally. Picot in the centre of dimple ring may be longer or shorter as desired.

Dimple Ring: 4 - 3 - 4 - 3 - 4 - 1, (2 of 1st half of ds) ----- (2 of 2nd half of ds), 1 + (to small picot to form dimple) 4 - 3 - 4 - 3 - 4. Reverse work.


Finger tat the following chain. All joints to the long picots are formed by just passing the core thread through the picot so that the chain will be a smooth curve.

Chain: 1 + (tie to paper clip by pulling up ball thread and passing shuttle through the loop. Tighten up and make sure it does not flip around the clip, make second half ds. Repeat tie one more time.) 4 + (to 2nd long picot) 4 + (to 1st long picot) 8 + (to 4th long picot) 4 + (to 3rd long picot) 8 + (join to centre of dimple ring) 8 + (to 6th long picot) 4 + (to 5th long picot) 8 + (to 8th long picot) 4 + (to 7th long picot). Cut & tie to base of dimple ring.

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Version 2

Ring: 6-2-2-6. Do not reverse work.

Chain: 18 + (to center picot of previous ring) 18. Tie to base of ring. Then tie to paper clip by pulling up ball thread and passing shuttle through the loop. Tighten up and make sure it does not flip around the clip, make second half ds. Repeat tie one more time if you want it more secure.) Cut & sew in ends.

Using another colour, tat another heart. If desired, tat the blue heart slightly bigger (by tatting chain: 19 + 19). After tatting chain and before tying to the base of ring, cut thread and slip the chain through previous heart to interlink both hearts. Tie to base of ring and to the paper clip. Sew in ends.
