



Following the diagram, tat two butterflies, making one a reverse of the other, joining the wings as indicated on diagram as you go. There are no ends to sew in this pattern, as the antennae are tied ends trimmed evenly.

Thread a bead onto a head pin, then the butterflies, threading through the two joining picots from front to back then back to front, then three or four more beads, depending on the length of your head pin. Using round-nosed pliers, make a ring of wire at the top, trim wire if necessary. Attach an earring finding.





Following the diagram, tat two identical flowers. Sew in ends.

Using a long head pin, thread three beads, then the flower (going from front to back then back to front through the two relevant joining picots) then thread three more beads. Using round-nosed pliers make a ring of wire. Trim if necessary. Attach an earring finding.
