Pattern 1: For Georgia Seitz 52 Earrings Project 2015



Rings: 5-5-5 Close. RW

Chain: 10-10

Repeat until you have four rings joined at the tip to each other at the center.

Do not cut thread, after the fourth ring, reverse work, continue.

Chain: 10-5-5 RW

Ring: 5-5-5-5 close, turn over

Chain: 10-10 RW

Ring: 5-5-5-5 close, RW.

Chain: 5-5-10

Join to the base of the ring nearest to form the curve. Tie and cut thread.

It is easy for beginners to make. You can make it in one pass without having to cut and join in the middle.



The pattern was born out of an error I had made while making one of Gun Blomqvist's motifs for my 25 Motif Challenge Project. I let the erroneous stitch count be and found that it morphed into a nice earring piece. I adjusted the stitches, added beads and the result is what you see here. Hope you like making it and enjoy wearing it. You can share it too among friends but please do credit me ©
