



Leaf With Dragonfly Earrings

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R = ring Ch = chain

- = picot + = join

prev = previous RW = reverse work

DNRW = do not reverse work

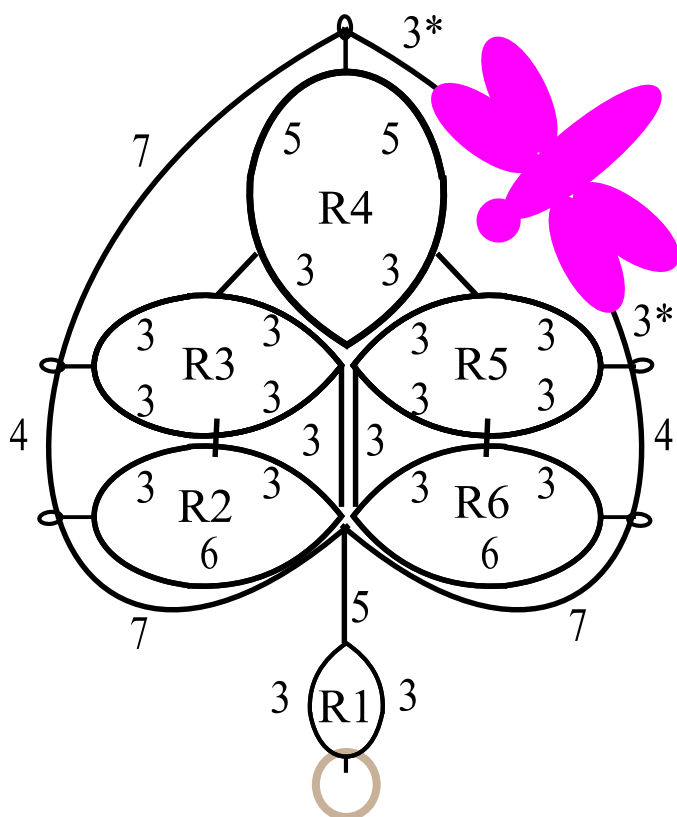
B = Bead

For these earrings you will need a jump ring, a bead, and an earring hook for each.

Made with one shuttle and a ball.

Bead is on Sht1 thread

If using a shaped bead, make sure to orient it to be correct when wearing and that thread is on the back side of bead.



R1 3++3 to jump ring (join twice) RW

Ch 5 RW

R2 6-3-3 RW

Ch 3 RW

R3 3+3-3-3 to 2nd p of prev R DNRW

R3+5-5-3 to 3rd p of prev R DNRW

R5 3+3-3-3 to 3rd p of prev R RW

Ch 3 RW

R6 3+3-6 to 3rd p of prev R

+ to base of R2 and 1st Ch RW

Ch 7+ to 2nd p of R6 - DNRW

Ch 4+ to 2nd p of R5 - DNRW

Ch 3* B 3* + to 2nd p of R4 - DNRW

Ch 7 + to 2nd p of R3 - DNRW

Ch 4 + to 1st p of R2 - DNRW

Ch 7 + to base of R2.

*The size of the beads will determine how many stitches on that chain

To put the bead on other side for 2nd earring switch the chains between [&]
