## Simple Shamrocks for St. Patrick's Day by Stephanie Wilson ©2015



Size 20 thread with one needle or one shuttle leaving a 18" tail.

1) R: 10, 4 first half, 4 second half, 7 - 3
2) R: 3 + (to R1) 7, 4 first half, 4 second half, 7 - 3
3) R: $3+$ (to R2) 7, 4 first half, 4 second half, 10 RW
4) Ch: 10 Use the long tail to make the chain. Cut, tie, hide ends if desired, or just use 'as is' on a card, as a tiny pin, etc.

For earrings make two shamrocks.
On the first one, add a vsp after the $2^{\text {nd }} d s$ on the first ring (marked with \&.) On the second one, add a vsp before the next to last ds on the $3^{\text {rd }}$ ring (marked with \&.)

Fasten an ear wire into the vsp on each shamrock.
Please examine the open space in the center of this sample. How could it be improved?
